STEAM ENGINE DAYS FOOD STAND

Thank you to all the volunteers who helped make our food stand a success! Each person who worked a shift, setup or tore down, made bars or pies, donated beverages and other miscellaneous items, or made cash donations was essential. Our two-day sales totaled \$9,466. Members' monetary donations remained about the same as but expenses were higher than previous years. At this time, the net income is \$8,760. A congregational meeting to determine use of this money will be held on **Nov. 19**. Persons willing to serve as 2024 chairmen are needed on or before the annual meeting when a decision will be made regarding whether or not to continue this project. If it is not continued, concrete plans to offset this income for our church with volunteers willing to put the plan in place will be needed at that time.

September 6, 2023 Council Meeting Highlights

- There were no formal pastoral acts at Mabel First during the month of August.
- Several items at the church and parsonage continue to be addressed by the property and management committee including the leak in the education wing, paint for the outside of the sacristy windows, ongoing issues in the parsonage.
- Youth will be staffing the MooMobile during Steam Engine Days. Wicklunds will bring the MooMobile to the Steam Engine grounds on Friday and a sign-up sheet has been established for youth and adult workers. Volunteers are still needed for the Steam Engine Days food stand.
- Joint confirmation classes will be held for two hours on the first Wednesday of the month at Mabel First and two hours on the third Wednesday at Henrytown with an end-of-year picnic scheduled May 1 at Scheie. Pastor Carla's office hours have been adjusted so she will be at the respective churches when the students arrive.

FROM THE INTERIM PASTOR

A voice cries out: "In the wilderness prepare the way of the LORD; make straight in the desert a highway for our God.

⁴ Every valley shall be lifted up, and every mountain and hill be made low; the uneven ground shall become level, and the rough places a plain.

⁵ Then the glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together, for the mouth of the LORD has spoken." (Isaiah 40:3-5)

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Grace and peace to you from God our heavenly Father and Jesus Christ the Lord and Savior. Amen.

As Autumn moves into full swing, sometimes events more closely resemble a stampeding mob than moments of enjoyment. As a society (at least according to our retail shops) we are always looking for the next big thing. Today's holiday is tomorrow's clearance deal. At times it can seem like we are rushing so fast toward the next event, we miss the joy of the present moment.

The season of Advent is designed to slow us down to prepare us for the greatest gift – the coming of the Messiah. This year we do run into a bit of an issue with the fourth Sunday of Advent falling on December 24th, but we still have a few weeks to prepare our hearts and minds for the coming of the Christ. During this time, we call our attention to the amazing gift God gives the world in revealing His glory to us in the form of His Son. We call our attention to God making a new covenant with humanity.

"And the Word became flesh and lived among us, and we have seen his glory, the glory as of a father's only son, full of grace and truth." (John 1:14) We are witnesses to this amazing blessing. 
